The building also features convenient indoor bicycle storage and additional shared laundry facilities. Situated in the heart of Mission, you'll be steps from acclaimed restaurants, boutique shopping, nightlife, the MNP Sports Centre, scenic Elbow River pathways, and just a 10-minute walk from downtown. Parking is a breeze with plenty of permitted spots available on 19th Avenue (permits can be obtained from the City) as well as a yearly lottery for one of 20 spots at the back of the building. Pets are welcome with board approval and the condo is well-maintained. The Athlone, designated a heritage site by the Cliff Bungalow-Mission Community Association in 2008, is a 46-unit, apartment-style condo rich in history and architectural charm. With neoclassical design features such as decorative lintels and pilasters, this building pays tribute to its namesake, Count Athlone, Canada's Governor General at the time of its official opening in 1940. Don't miss your chance to own a unique piece of Calgary's history in one of its most sought-after neighborhoods.
