Outside, the oversized lakeside deck is built on screw piles with composite decking, dual gas lines for a BBQ and fire table, a sunken hot tub area, and easy access down to the retaining wall and the lake. The fully fenced front yard is ideal for kids or pets, while the heated 25 by 23 garage handles toys, tools, and lake gear with ease. The basement is protected by three sump pumps, each with battery backup and alarm systems. Two air conditioners and new furnaces installed in 2024 provide efficient year round comfort.
